## Day 1



#### FOCUS:

### Earnest Intercession



#### SCRIPTURE:

ACTS 2:42, 4:31, 5:28, 6:4, 12 | JOHN 16:13, 14, 23 | ROMANS 8:24 | LUKE 11:13 | MATTHEW 7:7, 8  
ZECHARIAH 10:1 | JOEL 2:23 | REVELATION 1:18 | EPHESIANS. 3:18, 19 | PHILIPPIANS 2:13



#### KEY:

The Holy Spirit is Jesus’ special gift to His church. Without the presence of Jesus in our lives through the Holy Spirit, we are powerless to face the enemy. The presence of the Holy Spirit brings joy, peace, power, and victory in our walk with God. Without the infilling of the Holy Spirit, our Christian lives are joyless and powerless. We live lives of frustrated defeat rather than confident hope. Will you, right now, open your heart to the ministry of the Holy Spirit and pray this simple prayer?



#### PRAYER:

Dear Jesus,

Today, I thank you for Your promise of the Holy Spirit. Too often, I have neglected thinking about and asking for His infilling in my own life. Too often, I have attempted to live the Christian life in my own strength rather than trusting in the power of the Holy Spirit for victory.

Just now, I open my heart to you. I claim the promise of Your Holy Spirit. I repent of my lack of spiritual focus at times and of trusting in my own strength.

Believing that You will honor Your word right now, I accept the gift of the Holy Spirit. Thank you, Lord, for giving me Heaven’s most precious gift.

## Day 2



### FOCUS:

### Deeper Faith



### SCRIPTURE:

MATTHEW 4:4, 19:26, 26:32, 72 | ACTS 2:37-39, 4:8-12, 20, 5:29-32 | EPHESIANS 3:16  
ROMANS 12:3, 10:17 | 2 PETER 1:3-4 | HEBREWS 4:16, 12:2, | 1 JOHN 5:14 | LUKE 18:8  
MARK 14:29, 30, 31 | JOHN 5:30, 15:1-8



### KEY:

The Holy Spirit convicts us of sin. He reveals hidden attitudes and dispositional traits we may be unaware of. Our loving Lord longs for each one of us to manifest the grace of His character. As we are willing to confront our faults and surrender them to Jesus, the Holy Spirit will empower us to live godly lives. Our faith will increase as we see the Holy Spirit working miracles in our own lives. The disciples' testimony after Pentecost was the testimony of how Jesus, through the power of the Holy Spirit, changed their lives. He did it for them, and if we allow Him to, He will do the same for us.

## Day 3



### FOCUS:

### Heartfelt Repentance



### SCRIPTURE:

ACTS 1:1-4, 1:8, 2:38, 3:19, 5:31 | ROMANS 2:4, 8:34 | PSALM 51:10-11 | REVELATION 3:19  
LUKE 24:50-53 | JOHN 16:23, 24



### KEY:

God longs to do something in us so that He can do something through us. He longs to do something for us so He can do something with us. He longs to transform our character so He can empower our witness. What we are is more important than what we do. You can "do" without "being" but you can never "be" without "doing." Transformed character leads to active witness and service. Why not open your heart to Jesus right now and ask Him to reveal His character in your life?

## Day 4



**FOCUS:**  
**Honest Confession**



**SCRIPTURE:**  
PROVERBS 28:13 | LEVITICUS 5:5 | ACTS 2:5-8, 41-42, 24:16 | JOHN 16:7, 13, 18:40, 19:6  
MATTHEW 27:17, 24, 25 | 1 CORINTHIANS 12:1-13 | JOEL 2:28-32 | EPHESIANS 3:20



**KEY:**

When the Holy Spirit is poured out in His fullness, the impact is dramatic. As we open our hearts to the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, we, too, will have a significant impact on those around us. God will use us in powerful ways to reach others for His kingdom. We can expect God to open unusual doors of opportunity to share His Word with our family, friends, neighbors, and work associates. As we intercede for the people in our sphere of influence, God will do “exceedingly, abundantly above all that we ask or think” (Eph. 3:20). William Carey, who was called the father of modern missions, admonished his followers to “Expect great things from God, attempt great things for God.” Reach out by faith to receive all that God has for you. You can expect Him to work in ways that will amaze you.

## Day 5



**FOCUS:**  
**Loving Unity**



**SCRIPTURE:**

REVELATION 14:6-12 | 1 JOHN 4:7 | ZECHARIAH 12:8 | LUKE 11:13



**KEY:**

The promise of the Holy Spirit is for each generation. God wants to do more in us and through us than we can possibly imagine. At the time of the end, the Pentecost will be repeated in greater measure. The power of God will be poured out in its fullness to finish His work on earth. As God’s people enter into unity based on a common message, movement, and mission, God will pour out His Spirit in abundant measure for the finishing of His work on earth.

## Day 6



**FOCUS:**  
**Self-Examination**



**SCRIPTURE:**

JOHN 8:29, 15:26, 16:13, 14, 14:26 | ROMANS 8:14-17 | EPHESIANS 3:14-21 | REVELATION 14, 18:20  
MATTHEW 24:24



**KEY:**

The greatest evidence of a Spirit-filled life is a transformed life. It is a mind committed to doing God's will. It is the desire to please God in every aspect of our lives. The greatest evidence of a Spirit-filled life is not the manifestation of supernatural signs. The devil can counterfeit signs and wonders. Will you open your heart to the Holy Spirit's working and ask Him to reveal anything deep within your heart that hinders you from receiving the fullness of the Holy Spirit's power now?

## Day 7



**FOCUS:**  
**Sacrificial Humility**



**SCRIPTURE:**

JOEL 2:23 | EPHESIANS 5:18 | JOHN 16:7 | DEUTERONOMY 11:14



**KEY:**

What a privilege! What an opportunity! What possibilities! God longs to pour out His Holy Spirit in latter-rain power upon His church today. Will you open your heart right now and ask God if there is anything in your life that would keep you from receiving the fullness of His Spirit today?

## Day 8



**FOCUS:**  
**Obedient Surrender**



**SCRIPTURE:**

MATTHEW 26:39 | PSALM 40:8 | JOHN 8:29 | HEBREWS 10:7 | ACTS 4:13, 5:29 | PSALM 51:10-13  
LUKE 11:13



**KEY:**

The problem is not with God. He is more than willing to pour out His Holy Spirit on our thirsty souls. The problem is we are not ready to receive the fullness of God's blessing. Heaven's urgent appeal to God's end-time people is to prepare to receive the latter rain. He is calling us to prayer, repentance, confession, humility, and commitment. Will you bow your head right now and tell God you desire to make seeking the power of His Spirit a priority in your life?

# Day 9



**FOCUS:**  
**Joyful Thanksgiving**



**SCRIPTURE:**  
ACTS 2:46-47, 3:8-9, 16:25 | PHILIPPIANS 4:4 | EPHESIANS 5:19 | COLOSSIANS 4:2  
GALATIANS 5:22-23 | MATTHEW 6:33



**KEY:**  
Will you open your heart to God and plead for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit today? Will you ask Him to reveal the fruits of the Spirit in your life?

Are you willing to surrender everything not in harmony with His will?

Why not pray this prayer today:

Dear Lord,

I humbly acknowledge that I do not always reveal the fruits of the Spirit in my life. At times I am not patient, kind, and gentle. Sometimes I do not exhibit the grace of self-control. Today, I sincerely repent of my lack. I confess my sins and open my heart to You. I believe You can do more for me through Your Holy Spirit than I can ever do myself. I give You permission right now to transform my life to reveal the fruits of the Spirit and manifest Your loving character.

**SCRIPTURE:**  
MARK 16:15 | MATTHEW 28:18-19 | ACTS 1:8, 4:4, 6:7, 9:31, 20:35 | ZECHARIAH 10:1, 12:8  
HOSEA 10:12 | LUKE 11:13 | 2 PETER 1:4



**KEY:**  
All of Heaven longs to pour out the latter rain. As we seek God in humility, confessing our sins, humbling our hearts, surrendering our lives to His purposes, He will move powerfully. He will do for us what we could never do for ourselves. His love will be revealed to the world. His grace will change lives. Multitudes will rejoice in His truth. The work of God on earth will soon be finished, and Jesus will come.
